**HARVEST TIME      JOHN 4:31-38**

The message will begin with an experience with a lost child that Pastor Larry was involved with.

John 4:35 **"Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest."**

Let us look at three fields today and see how white they are white unto harvest.

**1. OUR OWN PERSONAL FIELD:** Many times, we will look at our neighbor's field and do not look at our own. Ours field should always be first:

**1.** Our Personal life and family:

(a.) Home,

(b.) Work,

(c.) Play.

How much time do we give to this in relation to what God would have us to do?

2. Our life to God's work. Many of us are neglecting our crops in relationship to the work of and word of God. Putting it a different way our gardens are growing up or drying up and we just do not care.

**Are we prepared to harvest what is ours?** (Gal 5:22-23) <sup>22</sup>  
**But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, <sup>23</sup> Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.**

**II. OUR NEIGHBOR'S FIELD:** I am afraid that this is one field that we are failing in more than any other.

1. When was the last time you spoke to your neighbor about Christ? About living the Christian life.

2. Folks, we have people that we meet daily, that are lost, unsaved, and headed for everlasting damnation. We must do more harvesting in this area. Jesus told his disciples to lift up their eyes and look. Are we looking up this morning?

**III. OUR MISSION FIELD:** We must never forget that Jesus commanded us to go into all the world. We harvest at home, but what about the other places around us. There is work to be carrying out people to be looked after and reached. We are the ones that He chose to do it, are we doing it?

What about you? Close with John 4:35
