Our devotion today is an outline of the message at Belfield Baptist Church for July 25, 2021.

WHAT DO YOU SEE MORE THAN OTHERS? MT 5:43-48

It is in this passage that Jesus is comparing the Christian with the sinner. I want us to look at verse 47 and ask ourselves what we do more than others.

- 1. What do we see more than others?***
- 2. What do we hear more than others?***
- 3. What do we know more than others?***
- 4. What do we do more than others?***

1. WHAT DO WE SEE MORE THAN OTHERS?

The greatest thing anyone can do is to see good in others more than themselves.

Way too often we are too zealous to look at others and we look at ourselves first.

We want to say Oh, how good I am and how sorry the rest of the world.

This is the worldly concept, but how about the Christian Concept? Jesus says in John 8:7: **So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.**

2. DO YOU SEE CHRIST MORE THAN OTHERS?

It is a sad day when we cannot look at mankind and see Christ: Matthew 25:35-40

- 35. For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:**
- 36. Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.**
- 37. Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink?**
- 38. When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee?**
- 39. Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee?**
- 40. And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.**

3. AS CHRISTIANS TODAY, WHAT DO WE SEE MORE THAN THE NON-CHRISTIAN?

- 1. Do we see Jesus as our personal savior?**
- 2. Do we see Jesus in our acts and relationship with others?**
- 3. Do we see Jesus in our relationship with the church?**
- 4. Do we see Jesus in the acts of others?**

The choice is ours; we see what we want to, do we see Jesus, or we see the world?
