***Our devotion today is an outline of the message at Belfield Baptist Church for July 25, 2021.***

**WHAT DO YOU SEE MORE THAN OTHERS? MT 5:43-48**

***It is in this passage that Jesus is comparing the Christian with the sinner. I want us to look at verse 47 and ask ourselves what we do more than others.***

- 1. What do we see more than others?***
- 2. What do we hear more than others?***
- 3. What do we know more than others?***
- 4. What do we do more than others?***

**1. WHAT DO WE SEE MORE THAN OTHERS?**

***The greatest thing anyone can do is to see good in others more than themselves.***

***Way too often we are too zealous to look at others and we look at ourselves first.***

***We want to say Oh, how good I am and how sorry the rest of the world.***

***This is the worldly concept, but how about the Christian Concept? Jesus says in John 8:7: **So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.*****

**2. DO YOU SEE CHRIST MORE THAN OTHERS?**

***It is a sad day when we cannot look at mankind and see Christ: Matthew 25:35-40***

- 35. For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:**
- 36. Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.**
- 37. Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink?**
- 38. When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee?**
- 39. Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee?**
- 40. And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.**

**3. AS CHRISTIANS TODAY, WHAT DO WE SEE MORE THAN THE NON-CHRISTIAN?**

- 1. Do we see Jesus as our personal savior?**
- 2. Do we see Jesus in our acts and relationship with others?**
- 3. Do we see Jesus in our relationship with the church?**
- 4. Do we see Jesus in the acts of others?**

***The choice is ours; we see what we want to, do we see Jesus, or we see the world?***
